Fly Swatter Sight Words

What you need:

- Index cards
- Fry's Sight Word List
- Fly Swatter

How to play:

- Choose 8-10 words from your sight word list.
- Write each word on an index card (one word per card)
- Spread the cards out on the floor or table.
- Your partner (adult, sibling, friend) will read a word from one of your cards.
- You will search for that word and swat it with your fly swatter.
- Your partner will read another word and you will find that one.
- Repeat this process until you have swatted all your sight words.

Alternative Materials:

- Instead of index cards- use small pieces of paper, use sidewalk chalk and play outside, write words on a whiteboard or on a large piece of paper, use post-it notes.
- Instead of a fly swatter- throw a ball, tap with a pencil, use your hand.

Creating Sentences

What you need:

- List of sight words
- Something to write with
- Something to write on

How to Play:

- Choose 8-10 sight words from your list.
- Take one word and create a sentence with that word in it.
- Repeat this process until you have made a sentence for all your words.
- Challenge yourself and try to use more than one of your words in a sentence.
- Read your sentences back to yourself and then read them again to someone else.

Alternative Materials:

- Use paper and pencil
- Chalk and a driveway or sidewalk
- Type words and sentences on a computer.

Unscramble Words

What you need:

- List of sight words
- Partner
- Something to write with
- Something to write on

How to Play:

- Choose 8-10 sight words from your list.
- Have your partner unscramble each word without you looking.
 - Ex: The word is "the", your partner could unscramble it and write "hte"
- You must unscramble the word back to its original form.
- Repeat this process until you have completed all your words

Alternative Materials:

- Use paper and pencil
- Chalk and a driveway or sidewalk
- Type words on a computer.

4 Times Each!

What you need:

- List of sight words
- Something to write with
- Something to write on

How to Play:

- Choose 8-10 sight words
- Write these sight words 4 times each.
- Be creative
 - Write words in different colors, in bubble letters, in small letters, in big letters.
 - Spell words with your body or with objects around your house.
- Repeat process until all words have been written/spelled.
